He went to St. Mary's School in Reedsville, where years later, his children attended the same school. Each winter he was transferred to Grimms Public School. The two schools never went at the same pace - so he had to make an adjustment every year.nnOn March 18, 1938, he was severely injured in an accident on the east end of Reedsville. He was driving a gas truck for the Reedsville Co-op at the time. He had both legs broken and was put in a body cast up to the chest with steel plates in his legs. His daughter, Catherine, used to sit on the cast up on his chest to visit. Dr. Cary and Arnold "Lummie" March, gave Veronica and the four children rides to Manitowoc to visit him in the hospital. He was hospitalized for five months to the day when he finally got to go home. Anne was born while he was there, and he had undergone three surgeries.
