Funeral services will be at 9 a.m. Saturday at Reedsville Funeral Home and at 9:15 a.m. at St. Mary Catholic Church, Reedsville, the Rev. Andrew Shimek officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery. Mr. Svatek was born Jan. 15, 1875, in the Town of Cato, son of the late Frank and Barbara Suchan Svatek. He married Agnes Vondracek July 6, 1897, at Reedsville and the couple observed its 65th wedding anniversary in 1962. Mrs. Svatek died Sept. 18, 1962. The couple farmed in the Town of Maple Grove until 1940. Mr. Svatek was a member of the Holy Name Society.
